Dear Parents,

We are very happy to welcome you and your children to an exciting new school year on Wednesday, September 9, 2026, at 8:30 AM. We hope and pray that this year will be a productive and rewarding one.

All children in Grades 1–8 are required to bring lunch to school, as it will be a full day of school with dismissal at 2:50 PM. The school lunch program will not begin until September 21, 2026. Please remember that soda is not permitted, and drinks may not be brought in glass bottles.

All students must be dressed in complete school uniform on the first day of school. During September and October, students will wear the summer school uniform.

Please Note: All Kindergarten students will attend classes on September 9, 10, and 11 from 8:30 AM until 11:45 AM. Beginning Monday, September 14, all Kindergarten students will attend school full time from 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM. We believe that this adjustment will make the first few days of school more enjoyable and comfortable for your children and will ease their transition to school. Please send a snack with your child.

There will be no registration of children on the first day of school. The office will open on August 31st and will accept tuition payments between the hours of 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM. Tuition payment must be made by September 3rd, unless you are enrolled in the FACTS Program. No tuition payments will be accepted on the first day of school.
